The hours of the show will be Saturday May 1st, 9:00 a.m. to 5p.m., and Sunday May 2nd, 9:00 a.m. to 5p.m. Please note that Saturday's time is tentative as we are still working on the entertainment lineup.

As with every year, we are making an effort to improve this event for you, the vendors, and also to bring in more attendees. In addition to making the fair entrances and signage more visually appealing, we are planning additional marketing and advertising efforts.

Vendor Guidelines associated with participating in the 2010 Canon City Music & Blossom Festival Craft Fair

Application Deadline: Applications must be received by April 10, 2010. All applications must be complete, Good Faith Pledge and Hold Harmless Waiver signed, Copy of Colorado Sales License and fees attached. It is the Canon City Music & Blossom Festival Committee's discretion to accept or reject any applicant.

Sales Tax: A separate check in the amount of \$50.00 is required as a deposit for your sales tax payment. The Blossom Festival Board of Directors will file a sales tax report and submit payment on your behalf. This will save you time and money required for obtaining your own City Sales Tax License. A Blossom Festival Chairperson or representative will be available at the end of each day to collect your daily sales tax for the City. We will collect 2% of your total sales for the taxes due to the City of Canon City. Final sales tax forms will need to be signed by each vendor as well. Provided your space is left in a clean manner and sales tax for both days has been collected your check will be returned to you. Failure to comply will result in the forfeiture of your \$50.00 deposit check. All non-profit organizations and information only businesses must still sign the tax form!

Booths: The booth fee will be held and cashed once your completed application has been accepted by the Craft Fair Chairperson. Please note that this is an outdoor event. We provide the space only; you must provide the materials that you require for your booth. No electricity is provided. Generators may be used. One week prior to the show, there will be NO REFUNDS. NO REFUNDS will be issued due to acts of nature.

Hours of Operation: All booths must be open for business Saturday, 9 am to 5 pm and Sunday, 9 am to 5 pm. If you choose to break down early, your final paperwork and deposit refund is subject to the availability of the Craft Fair Chairperson or their representative. Craft Fair load-in will be available starting at 4pm Friday and early Saturday morning. **No vehicles will be allowed on the park grass at any time. This shall include all loading times as well. No exceptions!**

Booth Security: Booths must be covered and able to withstand wind and rain. Booths may be left up overnight as there is security patrol on Friday and Saturday night from 10:00pm until 7:00am, but any merchandise should be secured and the festival is not responsible for loss or damage.

Return Check Policy: The Canon City Music & Blossom Festival reserves the right to reject any applicant for a returned check. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for each returned check.

Acceptance Notification: Vendor notifications of acceptance will be sent as soon as your completed application and all documentation and payment has been processed. You will receive additional information and booth location assignment in mid-April.
